Dear Friends,

As many of you know – over the last few years we've been expanding the way we meet people online by producing worship emails and creating digital connections. We've been very excited with the number of connections we've made – here, across the country, and even across the world.

Now – we are taking the next step – creating a NEW digital worshiping community called "connect.faith". The project is being funded by a grant from the PC(USA) called "1001 Worshiping Communities" designed to help an organization discern the scope of the new worshiping community. Over the past 4 months, we have put together a steering committee, made the first of several Facebook groups (creative writing as a spiritual practice), begun community conversations on a book we chose to read together, and are working to design, gather and create a digital first worship service.

Our steering committee worked together to develop a logo that highlights the connecting points for the project. (You'll see it at the top of the page.) We are excited about producing the first "season" of our digitally native worship service, which will be filmed on October 18 - 19. We are also in the process of developing a website for connect.faith, which will be a homebase of all the connections we are making.

The steering committee is made up of Bryan Bardin(distance member), Steve and Linda Berg, Jane Bullard (distance member), Evan Closser, David Fourie, Jacob Nemec (distance member), Kat Nemec, Mark Orendorf (distance member), Katelyn Westervelt, Jane Wong, and Debbie Bronkema. Please pray for the work of this team – as they work to meet people where they are and help them find their way to be community to one another in faith.

I'm very excited that our congregation can be part of such an exciting way of reaching out and meeting people where they are! We are a congregation that is truly open to change, and cares deeply about people both inside and outside of our walls. What a privilege it is to serve together with you in ministry!

### Property Committee Update

The Property Committee has completed repairs and upgrades to our parking lot.

In addition to one major and a few minor patches, two asphalt swales were built alongside the concrete steps to the upper parking lot. This will prevent rainwater from cascading down those stairs as it has it the past. Since melting snow will no longer be flowing down these stairs, ice formation will be greatly reduced if not eliminated. Finally, along the carriage house, seven concrete car stops were installed to provide a safer path for Great Beginnings children to access the playground area.

Money for this project came from the ongoing Preserve Our Property fund.

PEACEMAKING AND RECONCILIATION

The first Sunday in October, October 6th this year, is World Communion Sunday, when, celebrating our oneness in Christ with all our brothers and sisters around the world, we receive the annual Peace and Global Witness Offering as a way of continuing the ancient Christian practice of sharing what we have with brothers and sisters in need. Half of the receipts are used by the Presbyterian Mission Agency to promote peace and justice in cultures of violence, including our own, through collaborative projects of education and Christian witness. Mid councils retain 25% for ministries of peace and reconciliation. Our congregation will devote up to 25% of its Offering to connect locally with the global witness of Christ's peace.
