Stewardship Thoughts to Ponder

- "Seek joy in what you give, not in what you get." *Unknown*
- "What I spent is gone. What I kept I lost. But what I gave will be mine forever." *Tombstone epitaph*
- "The happiest people on earth are the people who have discovered the joy of giving." *Unknown*
- "We make a living by what we get; we make a life by what we give." Winston Churchill
- "All too often we regard stewardship simply as a matter of our giving to God, but this aspect is secondary. Before we can give, we must possess, and before we possess we must receive. Therefore, stewardship is, in the first place, receiving God's good and bounteous gifts. And once received, those gifts are not to be used solely for our own good. They must also be used for the benefit of others, and ultimately for the glory of God the giver. The steward needs an open hand to receive from God and then an active hand to give to God and to others." Murray J. Harris (Professor of New Testament Exegesis)

- What is the importance in calling Jesus the Word of God?
- What is meant in saying that Scripture has "authority" or that it's "inspired"?
- What are modern critical methods of Scriptural interpretation and what are their limitations and possibilities?
- To what degree are "historical" and "metaphorical" readings of Scripture simultaneously important and incomplete?
- How is the Jesus of the Gospels the same or different from the Jesus of history or the Jesus of modern criticism?

My prayer for this class is that the questions, analysis, problems, and discoveries raised bv these deepen thinkers may our understanding of the Word of God and therefore strengthen love for the living Word, freely given for us. Each week, we will spend our time discussing an article that I will send out prior to class. Come as you are or come having read the material, I have no doubt we will all benefit from learning together!

We will gather in the Campbell Room at 11:30am and after the lunch on November 11th.


